Executive Summary

Our client had an immediate need for an interim general counsel to handle corporate transactional responsibilities, including commercial contracts, corporate governance and strategic M&A, while they searched for a new general counsel. The Challenge

Our client experienced a sudden need for a new general counsel. They had a two-week timeframe in which to complete a search and onboard someone to handle the duties of a general counsel so there would not be a lapse in coverage as they undertook a more extensive search for a full-time replacement.

The Approach
